

SCIENCE LABS

CLASSES

The classes are from Play Group to XII. The school has been recently upgraded to Senior Secondary level and has all the three streams Science, Commerce and Humanities.

ONLINE CLASS

Online classes School uses zoom and google platform to conduct the online classes. School has designed it's own portal for conducting assessments.

EDUCATIONAL EXCURSION

The date and time of Parents-teachers meeting will be written in the E-diary (Bodhisukha School App) occasionally. So parents are requested to see the E-diary regularly.

SCHOOL ACADEMIC YEAR AND TIMINGS

OFFLINE CLASS

School Academic year begins on 1st April and ends on 31st March. Besides the Summer Vacation (30 days in May-June), there are 2 short vacations during the Puja (10 days) and Winter (10 days). The school functions on all days of the week.

Play Group to II : 9:00 am – 1:00 pm
Class III to XII : 9:00 am - 3:10 pm

School is open on Saturdays for classes III onwards 10:30 am to 3:10 pm. (Except third Saturday of every month)

ONLINE CLASS

As per online classes School academic session begins in the month of April and ends in the month of March. During the online sessions the summer vacations are about two weeks along with Puja vacations and winter vacations which are about , 7 -10 days. Classes are held on all days of the week online. Primary school is having 2 classes daily with a gap of an hour. Secondary School is having 4 classes daily with a gap of 20 mins starting from 9.30 am Senior Secondary Classes are having 6 classes daily starting from 9.30 am Saturdays we have club / inter-house activities and meetings for students from class 3 onwards

PLAY GROUP: The age requirement for Play Group class is 2.5+ on 31st March.

LKG: The age requirement for LKG class is 4+ on 31st March.

UKG: The age requirement for UKG class is 5+ on 31st March.

Admission procedure starts from the month of September which includes an interface with the child and the parents (The registration forms and prospectus are available in the school office free of cost or can be downloaded from the www.bds.school)

I to IX: Admission for meritorious students from class I made only if there are vacancies in the classes.

The school grants admission in Class XI in three streams viz. Science, Commerce and Humanities.

THE REGISTRATION FORM DULY FILLED AND RECEIVED BY THE SCHOOL OFFICE DOES NOT GUARANTEE ADMISSION IN THE SCHOOL

Forms submitted with the signature of parents / guardian and without a passport size photograph will not be entertained.

Originals of the following documents are to be submitted at the time of admission.

- 1) Birth Certificate issued by the Municipality / Block Office (for admission to classes Play Group to class – IX)
- 2) School leaving certificate and character certificate from the previous school (for classes I to XI)
- 3) Progress Report from the previous School.
- 4) Mark List issued by the Board (CBSE / ICSE / WBBSE) for admission to class XI.
- 5) Admit Card of Class X (for admission in class XI).
- 6) Vaccination Record.
- 7) Three copies of recent passport size photographs

12 CURRICULUM

The designing of a school curriculum requires a vision. Detailed evaluation and improvements are made year after year in the curriculum. This has made it imperative for us to devise the most effective method for the implementation of the requirements of the curriculum. In an academic year, the school has to have 210 working days out of which 180 days are devoted to intensive teaching and the additional 30 days are set aside for examinations and co-curricular activities.

PRE-PRIMARY:

The pre-primary wing of the school consists of Play Group, LKG and UKG and caters to the needs and demands of early childhood. Bearing in mind that the foundation of a child's personality is laid and two third of his intellect formed at this age, we have created an environment and a system of teaching which is entirely child friendly. Formal learning of the three Rs is introduced in Play Group & LKG. It finds a more prominent place in the UKG curriculum, which includes recognition, reading and writing of English and Hindi alphabets and small words and also basic arithmetical concepts.

PRIMARY CURRICULUM:

The syllabus become more broad based at this level and gradually the young learner is exposed to a wide range of subjects and study materials which is suitably graded. Apart from Mathematics, English, Bengali and Hindi, subjects like General Science and Social Science are introduced. Computer science is introduced in class I. As early as class I students learn to work on computers in the multimedia lab which has been specially equipped to meet the needs of the young learners.

CLASSES VI TO VIII: -

Students of class VI to VIII study English, Hindi, Bengali, Mathematics, Computer Science, Science (covering Physics, Chemistry, and Biology) and Social Science (covering History, Civics, and Geography). Co-curricular activities include Physical and Health education, Work experience and Art education.

CLASSES IX TO X:

Students of class IX to X study English, Hindi/Bengali, Mathematics, Science (covering Physics, Chemistry, and Biology) and Social Science (covering History, Civics, Geography and Economics). Co-curricular activities include Physical and Health education, Work experience and Art education.

13 **Classes XI to XII :**

Students of class XI to XII may take Science, Commerce or Humanities stream each of which covers 5/6 subjects.

SCIENCE STREAM:

Any 5 or 6 subjects from the following group are offered - English Core, Hindi Core, Bengali Core, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science, Physical Education, Applied Mathematics, Home Science and Fashion Studies and Commercial Art.

COMMERCE STREAM:

Any 5 or 6 subjects from the following group are offered - English Core, Hindi Core, Bengali Core, Mathematics, Business Studies, Economics, Accountancy, Information Practice, Physical Education, Applied Mathematics, Home Science and Fashion Studies and Commercial Art.

HUMANITIES STREAM:

Any 5 or 6 subjects from the following group are offered - English Core, Hindi Core, Bengali Core, History, Geography, Sociology, Political Science, Physical Education, Applied Mathematics, Home Science and Fashion Studies and Commercial Art.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The Children from Class III onwards are divided into 4 houses – RED, Yellow, Blue & Green. Inter House competitions in singing, Quiz, Elocution, Dance, Singing, Debate, Painting / Drawing, and Poster Designing are held on a regular basis. Facilities for Volleyball, Basketball, Badminton, Kho Kho, Athletics are available. Students are encouraged to participate in all Inter-House competitions, and Inter-School competitions, organized by the CBSE.

PRIZES

Proficiency prizes are given to the toppers of each class. Cups are given to the toppers of class X and XII Board Examinations and to the best all-rounder. Prizes in co-curricular activities are awarded for outstanding performance in all co-curricular activities held in the school.

TO GUARDIANS

Children will NOT be allowed to go home during school hours. Parents are requested not to make any social engagements or medical appointments during working hours. To ensure better discipline, parents are requested not to send their wards to school on the day, they have any such appointments.

Withdrawal and Refund of Fees

Once a student is admitted in a class, NO REFUND OF FEES IS PERMITTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES ON WITHDRAWAL or Absence from the School.

FOR BOYS: [From Play Group to Class X] - Check Shirt, Gray Pant & Red Check shirt and Biscuit colour Pant with School Tie, Belt. [For Class XI and XII] - Cream colour cheque Shirt, Grey Pant & School Tie

FOR GIRLS: [From Play Group to Class II] - Check Frock
[From III to Class X] - Light Pink colour Check Shirt, Biscuit colour Skirt & School Tie. [For Class XI and XII] - Cream colour cheque Shirt, Grey Skirt & School Tie

WINTER DRESS:

[From Play Group to Class X] - Dark Red Sweater or Blazer
(Both for boys and girls) [For Class XI and XII] - Blazer
(Both for boys and girls)

HOUSE DRESS:

According to house colour.

All students must wear the prescribed uniform when the school is in session. For boys, Black well polished leather shoes with laces (Naughty Boy/Cadet/Derby Type) and white socks. For Girls Black well polished leather shoes with buckles (Ballerina Type) with white socks.

SPORTS UNIFORM – Students participating in games and sports must purchase sports dress from school office.

As a prevention against mosquito born diseases boys are advised to wear full length trousers and Black Leggings for girls. Odomos or any other medicated cream for prevention.


For winter months students from Play Group to Class II must wear school pull over/cardigans with school Monogram attached to it. Students from class III onwards must wear School Blazer with school Monogram attached to it. Students may wear Maroon coloured caps or silk scarfs to cover their heads during winter. No other winter garments are allowed within the school.

Hair – Girls: – Must be tied with black rubber band or black clips. Girls with long hair must do two Pony Tails or two Plats. Boys: – Cut short – above the shirt collar and behind the ears.

N.B – Girls students in school are not allowed to wear any jewellery except small earrings. Any child who comes to school untidily dressed or incorrect uniform will be sent home.
